Kennel Cough Acknowledgement

(Bordatella Pertussis)

Please remember:

- Similar to the flu vaccine, the kennel cough vaccine only protects against approximately 7-strains and there are approximately 40 + strains.
- Because of the many different strains, a dog that has been vaccinated, can still develop cold-like symptoms even if they have been vaccinated, from numerous factors such as: stress (new environment), environmental factors (airborne bacteria), and the vaccine itself.
- It is recommended that you vaccinate your dog at least 2 weeks prior to boarding them to allow any symptoms from the vaccine to run its course.

Bordatella Pertussis is essentially the common cold for a canine.

- A dog will show signs of coughing, runny nose, and possibly a mild fever
- Most often symptoms will run their course without needs for veterinarian care
- It is easy to catch, as not all strains are included in the vaccine
- If treatment is necessary for the discomfort of the dog, most times an expectorant cough syrup is administered.
